## After you arrive Canada



Apply Social Insurance Number (SIN) right away



Apply GST/ HST Credit after you obtain SIN

## February to April – Tax Season



Ask your employer for T4

- February to April is Canada's tax season, and usually employer will give employees T4 slip for income report around January and February.



Collect Rental receipts

- In some provinces, like Ontario, you can apply for rental credit if you have rental receipts.



Collect receipts for medical expense, you may deduct some tax.

File tax return



You can file tax via online service or mailing.

## When you leave Canada



Call 1-800-959-8281 CRA to inform them your date of departure and ask to stop the benefit.

After you leave Canada, you still can report your income for previous year. However, since your address is not in Canada, you can only file tax by paper.
